Tractor Safety Training



All youth aged 14 and 15 who work on a farm or ranch other than their own **MUST** be certified through a **Hazardous Occupations Course** to obtain a **Farm Husbandry Permit** or “farm permit” without further testing.

Successful completion of this training in Nebraska will allow youth to operate a tractor over 20 horsepower, and connect or disconnect an implement or any of its parts to or from a tractor. Students age 14 and over may complete the driving course in any of the following locations after successful online class completion or attending a Hands-On Safety Day (North Platte on May 22- 9am-3pm, or Grand Island on May 30- 9am-3pm).
